Guidelines for Certificate of Free Sale

Certificate of Free Sale

The Saint Lucia Bureau of Standards will issue a Certificate of Free Sale when requested by individuals or companies exporting foods, goods, dietary supplements and beverages produced in St. Lucia.

In order to apply for a Certificate of Free Sale you must have the following:

- Request for the certificate
- List of product (s)
- Original label(s) for each product
- Description of the product(s)
- Product name
- Name and address of manufacturer
- Destination of the goods
- State number of certificates required
- State whether you want all the products together on each certificate, or one product on a separate certificate.
- Evidence that all legal requirements pertaining to the product have been met.

Some Countries require the issuance of “Certificate of Free Sale” or other times called “Certificate of Export” or “Certificate to Foreign Government”. These requests are to seek assurances that products offered for entry into their country comply with the legal requirements for distribution in our domestic commercial market. Many countries rely on this certificate before allowing products to enter their country for distribution.



It applies only to products manufactured here in St. Lucia.
